Elk Attack

This is the unreleased port of the arcade game “Electric Yoyo.” Your job is to move the orange yoyo around the screen collecting the purple squares with the green tinted sides. The squares with the little yellow squares on them turn you invisible from your enemies, the yellow lines with eyes.

Ixion

No, this isn't finished because it says “IXIO,” when you get the white flashing squares, you get a letter from the word IXION. 



Thwacker


I'm stupid.
